

Q1. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?




Q2. How well were the teachers able to communicate?


Q3. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as













Q10. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.



Q11. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.











Q16. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




