Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on July 7, 2020

The meeting began with a brief introduction of the attainments and performances of the departing session by the Principal and the IQAC chairperson. She informed the members of the achievements made by the institution in the session 2019-20. All the members showed their consent. Discussions were held on various points of the agenda and following resolution was passed by the members:

- 1. Regarding online admissions Principal, Dr. Manpreet Kaur, discussed with the committee members about the changes required in admission process for the session 2020-21 due to COVID-19. S Manjit Singh, Head Computer Science, Department suggested that keeping in mind the social distancing norms and to solve the queries of students, the college should start e-counselling desk. Further, it was discussed and decided in the meeting to update the college website with online admission form so that the students do not face any difficulty in getting admission. The details to be included in the form were discussed and finalised by the members
- 2. Dr. Manpreet Kaur pointed out that there was a possibility of the lockdown period going longer than expected and therefore it was imperative that effective and definitive strategies should be planned for smooth conduct of teaching learning. The Principal said that a mechanism was being planned for conducting institutional activities in online mode, in case pandemic and consequent lockdown grew longer than expected. She also spoke about to set up for Bridge Courses.
- 3. Keeping in view the need of hour Dr. Jitender Kaur suggested for Capacity building workshops for teaching and non-teaching staff to meet needs of pandemic.
- 4. Towards Community Service, it was discussed in the meeting that continuing with its tradition of discharging its social responsibility, the college will take another initiative towards community service of helping the frontline worker. It was proposed to donate masks for frontline workers made by students.
- 5. Regarding Celebration of 400th birth anniversary of Guru Teg Bahadur Sahib ji, it was proposed that the college should come forward by involving the youth in various activities and showing them the path of peace, non-violence and sacrifice. Towards this direction, Mrs. Ravinder Kaur suggested to plan certain activities.
